




# + HOW TO PLAY +

- 1 Use your GPLD library card to register from home or at the library, beginning Dec. 14.
- 2 Set your own reading goals and determine how much you need to fill in one . Count by minutes or books, whatever works best for you.
- 3 Fill in the first 16  by reading. Fill in the next 16  by reading or by choosing activities from the list.
- 4 Bring your completed log to Youth Services to select a prize book and be entered into a prize drawing. Prizes must be claimed in person and will be available Dec. 26, 2018 – March 1, 2019.
- 5 Bonus logs may be completed for additional entries into the prize drawing.

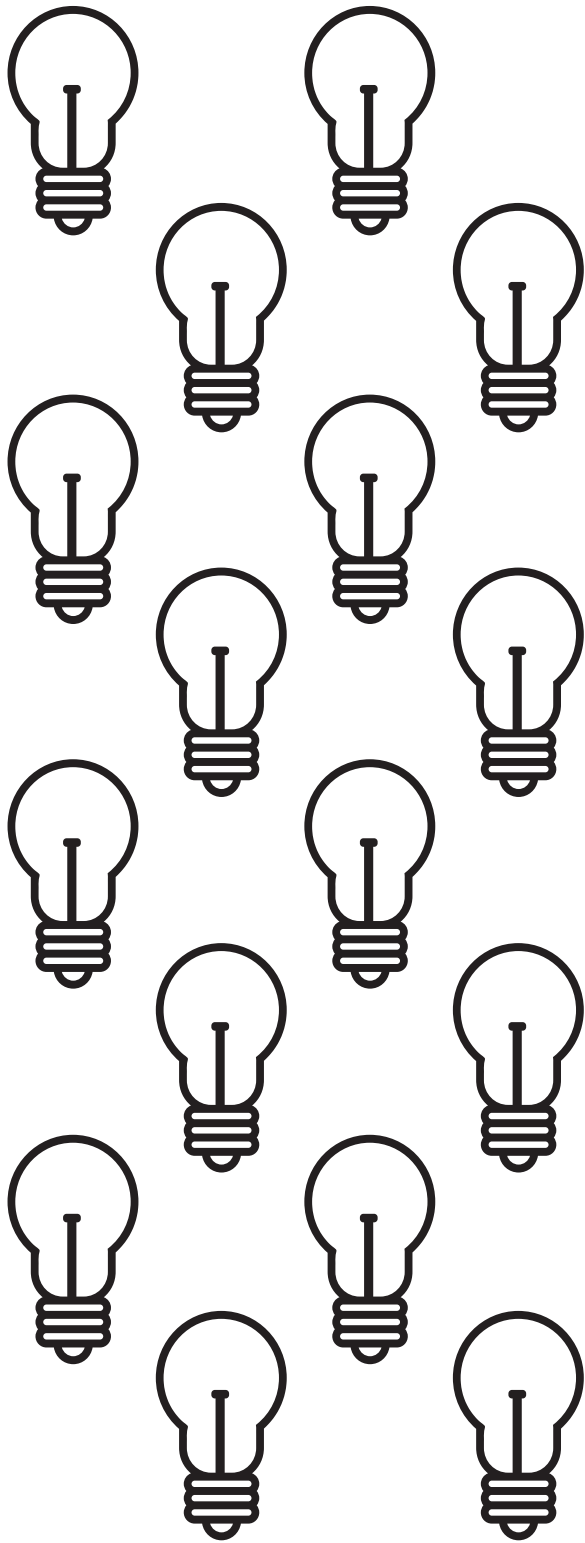
